

**Minutes of Work Session
Town of Orleans
December 3, 2025
9:00 a.m.**

Orleans Town Council met for its monthly general work/study session on Wednesday, December 3, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance included Council President John H. Lindley, Councilman John F. Noblitt, Councilman Randy Clark, Town Attorney John-Paul Isom, Town Marshal Jim Lindsey, Fire Chief Ronnie Roach and Town Supt., Daniel Houchin.

Guests: Kara Schmidt, Team Peace

Council President Lindley called the meeting to order with the pledge to the Flag followed by a brief prayer.

Kara was present to seek the town's support for a proposed Kids Bike Camp in Orleans in late June of 2026. Schmidt also requested the involvement of the Orleans Police in some of the sessions regarding overall bike safety etc.

Council members expressed their support for the project and offered the town's involvement with the endeavor in any way possible.

In other matters, Council members learned that the town had been chosen as a receipt of a Community Crossing Matching Grant in the amount of \$128,786.74 with the local match being \$32,197.00 and taken from the town's EDIT monies. The project will include both repaving and street rejuvenation. A bid opening is expected to take place at the regular December meeting.
