A quote was approved for Taylor Spraying for mosquito and gnats this season in the amount of \$41 per mile.

Fire Chief Ronnie Roach reported 35 runs for his department for the month of March. The numbers included 32 EMS, 1 fire, 2 wrecks, 1 meeting and 1 training session.
